

What you MUST bring

1 Duffel bag for all of your items. This must be clearly marked with your name, city, and the church you attend.

NO suitcases. NO wheels. NO exceptions.

Sleeping bag with pillow

10 plain white short-sleeved t-shirts, NO v-necked shirts.

10 pairs of underwear

10 pairs of white socks

6 pairs of blue jeans, NO capris, NO other colors, NO ripped jeans

Mandatory for ALL: Belt

Mandatory for girls: 4 White or Nude sports bras

2 pairs of running shoes, including 1 pair of “worn” sneakers (wear these on the bus to the camp on Tuesday!)

2 towels and washcloths

Shampoo, body wash

Deodorant

Shower shoes

Comb and/or brush

Toothbrush and toothpaste

Sunscreen and Chapstick

Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil

Any medication (must be registered and turned in to the medical staff before leaving for the camp)

A long-sleeved sweatshirt for paintball participation

A lightweight jacket or windbreaker

Comfortable clothes to be worn on the ride home (you may not wear these during the week)

What you must NOT bring

Phones, watches, headphones, earbuds, CDs, DVDs, players, mp3 players, cameras, video equipment, etc.

ANYTHING electronic, battery-operated, or requiring electricity

Make-up of any kind, bows, or hair barrettes

NO hair or eyelash extensions of any kind

Shaving cream, cologne, scented lotion, or razors

Blow dryer, curling iron, crimpers, hair straightener, rollers, gel or nail polish.

NO earrings or piercings of any kind

NO “permanent” bracelets or necklaces- They will be cut off

Open-toed shoes or sandals (except shower shoes)

Food/snacks- including gum, candy, cookies, etc

Alarm clock

Photos

Wallet (turn into administrators before leaving for camp)

Magazines or books (other than the Bible)

Games (electronic or otherwise)

Sports equipment (football, basketball, etc.)

Weapons of ANY type, firecrackers, caps, etc.

Any practical jokes whatsoever

If you arrive with piercings, gauges fake nails, painted nails, or fake eyelashes, you will be required to remove them or you will be sent home.
